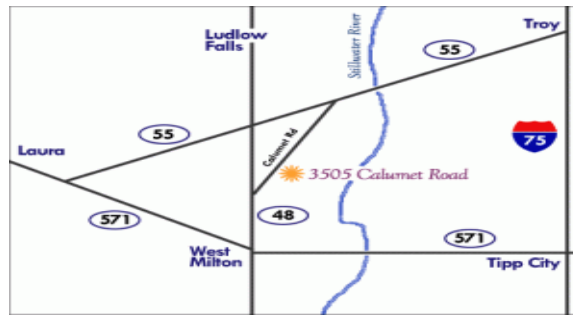

Directions:

From Interstate 75 southbound

- Take Exit 73 (SR 55), turn right at the end of ramp (headed west).
- Continue on SR 55 approximately 5 miles, go over the Stillwater River bridge, then left on Calumet Road.
- Continue approximately 1 mile on Calumet, turn left into Center entrance.

From Interstate 75 northbound

- Take Exit 68 (SR 571), turn left at the end of ramp (headed west).
- Continue on SR 571 approximately 7 miles, go over the Stillwater River bridge, then turn right on SR 48.
- Continue approximately 1.1 miles on SR 48, turn right onto Calumet Road. Turn right into Center entrance.

*** NaProTECHNOLOGY**

NaProTECHNOLOGY is an emerging science of women's healthcare that approaches procreative and gynecologic health problems in a way which is completely cooperative with the menstrual and fertility cycles and in a way which is morally acceptable to people of all faiths. This reproductive science maintains the integrity of the human person, respects the dignity of women and supports the institution of marriage.

A central tool of NaProTECHNOLOGY is the Creighton Model Fertility Care System. This new educational technology (which has been developing for over 30 years) allows a woman to monitor a variety of different biological markers (bio-markers) that reflect the occurrence of various hormone events during the course of her menstrual cycle. Doctors can use these bio-markers along with other medical technologies to solve problems of infertility, repetitive miscarriage, recurrent ovarian cysts, polycystic ovarian syndrome, endometriosis, hormonal abnormalities, and abnormal bleeding.
